Philippians.2:5-8

- 5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,
- 6 who, as He already existed in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,
- 7 but emptied Himself by taking the form of a bondservant and being born in the likeness of men.
- 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death: death on a cross.

 - · He was focused on fulfilling
 - · The Will of God

Be Instant in Season, Out of Season

Matthew 24:42-51

- 42 "Therefore be on the alert, for you do not know which day your Lord is coming.
- 43 But be sure of this, that if the head of the house had known at what time of the night the thief was coming, he would have been on the alert and would not have allowed his house to be broken into.
- 44 For this reason you must be ready as well; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think He will.

Faithful Servant Gives importance to everything

Faithful Servant Must strive for perfection!

Don't labor for the reward!

Luke 17:7-10.

7"Now which of you, having a slave plowing or tending sheep, will say to him after he comes in from the field, 'Come immediately and recline at the table to eat'?

Luke 17:7-10.

- 8 On the contrary, will he not say to him, 'Prepare something for me to eat, and properly clothe yourself and serve me while I eat and drink; and afterward you may eat and drink'?
- 9 He does not thank the slave because he did the things which were commanded, does he?
- 10 So you too, when you do all the things which were commanded you, say, 'We are unworthy slaves; we have done only that which we ought to have done.'"

A faithful servant -

will always be ready to serve the master and His people.

always labors, multiplies, and produces for the Lord.

will be faithful not only in big things, but in little things also.

must strive for perfection.

must be faithful as God is faithful toward us.

must not compare himself with the fellow laborers!

must works faithfully, because he loves his master, and not for the reward.
